Tips to make your booth more sustainable



## **GBTA Goes Green!**

With the help of our suppliers, vendors, and partners, GBTA is on a journey to make Convention as green as possible. We will be calculating our emissions related to this annual event so that we can benchmark our progress.

### **Green Highlights:**

- Working with Thrust Carbon to calculate emissions related to Convention and offsetting a portion of those emissions
- During Convention, encouraging staff and attendees to walk, seek out hybrid or electric vehicle options, or utilize public transport
- Offering shuttle routes for attendees and detailed shuttle info to drive usage
- Providing an option for exhibitors to donate used materials to a local charity through the Good Neighbor Program
- Similar to 2022, we are not placing aisle carpet on the Expo Floor to cut down on waste
- Using suppliers with sustainable policies/practices in place as much as possible
- Utilizing a Green Badge to encourage attendees to commit to reducing their emissions and waste during Convention (see last slide)



# **How Can Exhibitors Help?**

#### **Pre-Convention:**



- Consider rail or electric/ hybrid car rental options if possible
- If flying, book direct flights in economy class
- During registration, calculate and offset your emissions using our <u>offsetting tool</u>



### **Getting to Convention:**

Utilize public transport or green options during travel to and from Convention

#### **Promotional Materials:**



- Use digital options over printed materials where possible
- · Don't bring more brochures than you need
- Choose reusable and useful giveaways that people are likely to keep using
- Use post-consumer recycled paper and vegetable-based inks for any printing needs
- Make printed materials timeless (without dates) so they can be reused



# **How Can Exhibitors Help?**

#### Packaging & Shipping:

- Avoid Styrofoam packing peanuts (not recyclable)
- Choose biodegradable/ reusable packing materials
- Use recyclable/ recycled packaging

### Food & Beverage:

- Order sustainable (locally produced, and/ or vegetarian) food for your booth catering
- Avoid single-use cups and cutlery
- Ask your team to bring their own reusable water bottle (water stations will be available)

#### **Post-Convention Actions:**

- Donate used materials via the Convention Center's <u>Good Neighbor Program</u>.

# Earn your Green Badge

Do you want to help make Convention more sustainable?

Commit to at least three out of these five actions, and add a green marker to your badge:

- Bring a water bottle to all programming
- 3. Separate your waste thoughtfully and use the correct bins
